FEBRUARY 26 - 27 STATE TOURNAMENT

We had an outstanding State Tournament. **Beka Mahlow became Martin High School's 2nd State Champion in Three years.** She pinned her way through the competition. The Final was a regional championship rematch against Brittany Jones from Coppell. Beka was down 5-9 in the third period. She ended up pinning her opponent with a stack to take the 165 pound title. Rachel Mahlow also had a great tournament the 119 weight class. She had a tough 1st round, but ended up wrestling back to place 6th in the state. Congrats to these two young ladies. Martin ended up placing 8th out of 85 teams. The Martin Wrestling Program combined girls and boys were 2 state champs, 2 third placers, 1 5th placer and 2 6th placers. **Coach Patrick Dunn also received the All-State Boys Coach of the year.** This was a great year for Martin Wrestling.

FEBRUARY 15 - 16 REGIONAL TOURNAMENT

We had three girls qualify for the Regional Tourn. Beka Mahlow won the 165 weight class against Brittany Jones from Coppell and took first.
